AgTech REEU is a Research and Extension Experiences for Undergraduates (REEU) Program funded by the USDA and focused on innovative technologies that support sustainable agriculture and development.



Program highlights:

- An 8-week summer internship with \$500/week stipend, travel to TAMU-CC, on-campus housing and meal allowances (\$140/week).
- Webinars during fall & spring semesters.
- Conference opportunities and travel support.
- Training with extension experience, field trips, workshops, guest speakers, and hands-on activities.
- Research topics focused on <u>Internet of Things (IoTs)</u>, <u>Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS)</u>, and <u>Geospatial</u> <u>data analytics</u>.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be U.S. citizens or permanent residents
- Enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at a community college or four-year university
- Majoring in STEM, Agriculture, or related field of study
- Have cumulative GPA of 2.8+



Students from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.



Application deadline is Feb. 15, 2024
